 - Treated group members, staff, and the instructor in a professional and respectful manner
 - Tardy for portions of the lab, but not excessively so
 - Exhibited proper respect for safety
- **Poor**, means exhibiting all of the positive and one or more of the negative following attributes:
 - Did some, but not a fair share of work
 - Frequently worked separately to the exclusion of the group
 - Treated group members, staff, and the instructor in a professional and respectful manner
 - Excessively and/or repeatedly tardy
 - Exhibited proper respect for safety
- **Unacceptable**, means exhibiting any of the following negative behaviors:
 - Contributed an extremely small amount to group work
 - Solely worked to the exclusion of the group
 - Treated group members, staff, or the instructor in an unprofessional or disrespectful manner
 - Missed laboratory meetings without consulting with the instructor
 - Exhibited disrespect for safety
 - Exhibited disregard for laboratory equipment
